Additional Guidance Notes for applicants applying to be Naturalised or Registered as a British Citizen on the Isle of Man

The current application fees are as follows:

Naturalisation – married to British Citizen 6(2)	£1236.00 (includes Ceremony fee)
Naturalisation – not married to British Citizen 6(1)	£1236.00 (includes Ceremony fee)
Registration – adult (except 4(C))	£1121 (includes Ceremony fee)
Registration – adult – 4(C)	£ 80.00 (includes ceremony fee)
Registration – single minor	£936.00
Declaration of Renunciation of British Citizenship	£272.00
Application for a letter or document confirming a person's immigration or nationality status, or confirming that a person is not a British Citizen	£ 198.00

The full fee must be paid at the time of application.

Payments are accepted by cheque, cash or debit card only, and cheques should be made payable to the **"Isle of Man Government"**.



If you withdraw your application, or it is unsuccessful, your fee will be retained to meet the processing costs, although the £80.00 Ceremony element of the fee (if applicable) may be refunded.

The knowledge of language and life requirement (KoLL)

All applicants for Naturalisation as a British citizen will need to meet the knowledge of language and life requirement, unless they are exempt.

You can demonstrate your knowledge of language and life in the UK in three ways:

1. Passing the Life in the UK test, and **either**
2. having a qualification in English at B1 level or above of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), which includes assessment of speaking and listening, **or**
3. are considered automatically to meet the English language component of the KoLL requirement

Citizenship Ceremony

All successful applicants aged 18 years or over will be notified in writing of the date of their Citizenship Ceremony which will take place in the Isle of Man.

Application Forms

The applicant and both referees must sign and date the application form no earlier than **one** month prior to the date that the application is submitted.

Please note that laminated certificates and documents are NOT acceptable.
