IMMIGRATION AND ASYLUM ACT 1999

REPORTING OF SUSPICIOUS CIVIL PARTNERSHIPS REGULATIONS 2012

Laid before Tynwald: 15 January 2013
Coming into Operation: 1 January 2013

The Clerk of the Rolls makes the following Regulations under 24A(4) of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (an Act of Parliament)¹, as it has effect in the Isle of Man².

1 Title

These Regulations are the Reporting of Suspicious Civil Partnerships Regulations 2012.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 January 2013.

3 Reporting of suspicious civil partnerships

For the purposes of section 24A of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (an Act of Parliament) a registrar to whom notice of civil partnership has been given under section 9 of the Civil Partnerships Act 2011 (an Act of Tynwald)³ shall –

- (a) report his suspicions to the Governor by making a report in writing or other permanent form giving the information specified in the Schedule, and
- (b) forward that report to the Immigration Office, Chief Secretary's Office, Bucks Road, Douglas, Isle of Man IM1 3PN.
