NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE
(DENTAL CHARGES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2010

Approved by Tynwald 13th July 2010

Coming into operation 1st September 2010

The Department of Health after having consulted as required by section 42(5) of the National Health Service Act 2001¹ makes these regulations under section 32(1) of that Act.

1 Title

These Regulations are the National Health Service (Dental Charges) (Amendment) Regulations 2010.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald², these Regulations come into operation on 1st September 2010.

3 Amendment of the National Health Service (Dental Charges) Regulations 2006

(1) The National Health Service (Dental Charges) Regulations 2006³ are amended as follows.

(2) In Regulation 3 (calculation of charges) –

- (a) in paragraphs (1) and (5) for “£15.50” substitute “£16.50”;
- (b) in paragraph (2) for “£42.40” substitute “£45.60”; and
- (c) in paragraphs (3) and (4) for “£189.00” substitute “£198.00”.

(3) In Schedule 3 (band 3 charges – provision of appliances) –

- (a) in paragraph (a) for “porcelain, composite or acrylic mastique veneers” substitute “laboratory fabricated porcelain or composite veneers”;

- (b) paragraph (i) is revoked; and
- (c) in paragraph (m), after the word “other” insert “non-metallic”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the National Health Service (Dental Charges) Regulations 2006 the (“2006 regulations”) by –

- (a) increasing the charges payable for –
 - (i) a Band 1 course of treatment from £15.50 to £16.50 (see regulation 3(20(a)));
 - (ii) a Band 2 course of treatment from £42.40 to £45.60 (see regulation 3(2)(b)); and
 - (iii) a Band 3 course of treatment from £189 to £198 (see regulation 3(2)(c)).
- (b) amending the references to veneers in the list of appliances for which a Band 3 charge may be made and recovered in Schedule 3 of the “2006 regulations” to clarify that only laboratory fabricated veneers may be used (see regulation 3(3)(a));
- (c) removing the reference to “crowns in other materials” in the list of appliances for which a Band 3 charge may be made and recovered in Schedule 3 to the “2006 Regulations”(see regulation 3(3)(b));
- (d) amends the reference to “bridges in other materials” in the list of appliances for which a Band 3 charges may be made and recovered in Schedule 3 of the “2006 regulations” to clarify the materials which may be used (see regulation 3(3)(c)).
