



Shipping forecast for the North Irish Sea

Synopsis: Low pressure lies over Iceland, with ridge from the Azores to Southern Britain.

Wind: South or southwest force 3 or 4 occasionally 5 on Monday afternoon, veering west tomorrow evening.

State of Sea: Smooth or slight.

Weather: Occasional mist or perhaps fog patches, with the risk of a shower overnight.

Visibility: Mostly good, but becoming poor or very poor in mist or fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: West or northwest 3 or less.

State of Sea: Mainly slight.

Weather: Occasional rain overnight into Tuesday, then fair.

Visibility: Moderate or good.
