



# Shipping forecast for the North Irish Sea

Valid for 24 Hours

Issued on Friday, 24 November 2017 at 4:15pm by Ronaldsway Met Office

**Warnings:** Strong winds.

**Synopsis:** High pressure in mid-Atlantic will track east-southeast and become centred to the southwest of Ireland. A deep low in the Norwegian Sea will move slowly south-southeast.

**Wind:** West or northwest force 4 or 5, occasionally 6, increasing 5 or 6 this evening. Remaining west or northwest on Saturday, increasing 6, occasionally 7, during the morning.

**State of Sea:** Slight or moderate, becoming mainly moderate overnight and moderate, occasionally rough, during Saturday.

**Weather:** Occasional showers.

**Visibility:** Good, occasionally moderate.

## Outlook for the following 24 hours:

**Wind:** West or northwest force 6, occasionally 7, decreasing 5 or 6 during Sunday afternoon.

**State of Sea:** Moderate or rough.

**Weather:** Showers, becoming isolated.

**Visibility:** Good, occasionally moderate at first.
