



Shipping forecast for the North Irish Sea

Synopsis: Low pressure to the west of the British Isles and high pressure over continental Europe.

Wind: Variable 3 or 4, becoming south or southeast 4 or 5 during Sunday morning, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

State of Sea: Mainly slight.

Weather: Widespread fog, becoming more patchy late morning on Sunday, otherwise mist. Gradually becoming fair later.

Visibility: Very poor in fog. Moderate or poor in mist. Moderate or good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: South or southeast 3 or 4.

State of Sea: Slight.

Weather: Mainly fair.

Visibility: Moderate or good.
