

Shipping forecast for the North Irish Sea

Synopsis: Low pressure over France, moving north-eastwards, and another low near Iceland

moving southwards.

Wind: Mainly east or northeast 2 to 4, backing north tomorrow morning, gradually

backing south or southwest through the day, and increasing 4 or 5 in the evening.

State of Sea: Smooth or slight, building slight occasionally moderate tomorrow evening.

Weather: Mainly fair. **Visibility:** Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in the east of the area, backing south overnight

into Monday, then increasing 6 or 7 Monday morning. Decreasing 4 or 5 in the

evening.

State of Sea: Slight or moderate, building moderate Monday morning, then becoming moderate

or rough for a time in the afternoon & evening.

Weather: Scattered showers tomorrow evening, then outbreaks of rain spread from the west

Monday morning.

Visibility: Good, occasionally moderate in rain or showers.
