

## **Shipping forecast for the North Irish Sea**



## Valid for 24 Hours Issued on Saturday, 14 June 2025 at 11:30am by Ronaldsway Met Office

**Warnings:** Strong winds for a time

**Synopsis:** Complex area of low pressure over the Irish Sea will move slowly north.

Wind: Cyclonic 3 to occasionally 5 settling southwest 4 or 5 occasionally 6 this afternoon,

decreasing west 3 or 4 this evening, then backing southwest 4 or 5 tomorrow

morning.

State of Sea: Mainly slight.

**Weather:** Outbreaks of rain, or showers, becoming mainly fair tonight. **Visibility:** Good, falling moderate or poor at times in rain or showers.

## **Outlook for the following 24 hours:**

Wind: Southwest 4 or 5 becoming mainly west or southwest 3 or 4 tomorrow evening.

State of Sea: Slight.
Weather: Mainly fair.
Visibility: Good.
