Wind: Variable or Southeast 2 or 3.

State of Sea: Smooth.

Weather: Fair.

Wind: Variable 2 or 3, settling North or Northwest 3 or 4 later tomorrow morning or early

afternoon, then 4 or 5 later in the afternoon and evening. Decreasing North or

Northwest 3 or 4 overnight into Friday.

State of Sea: Smooth, becoming slight or moderate for a time, then slight later. **Weather:** Mainly fair, but a risk of mist patches in the west of the area for a time.

Visibility: Good, falling poor in any mist patches.
