

Shipping forecast for the North Irish Sea



Valid for 24 Hours Issued on Sunday, 30 November 2025 at 11:30am by Ronaldsway Met Office

Warnings: Strong to gale force winds.

Synopsis: A ridge across the Irish Sea will decline later today, with Atlantic fronts then

moving across the area.

Wind: West 3 or 4, backing West or Southwest this afternoon, then backing and

increasing South or Southwest 6 or 7 this evening and at first tonight, occasionally touching gale 8 in places. Then gradually decreasing Variable or West 3 or 4

tomorrow morning.

State of Sea: Slight, building moderate or rough this evening. Becoming moderate later

tomorrow morning.

Weather: Fair, then rain spreads from the west this evening; heavy and persistent at times

tonight and at first tomorrow.

Visibility: Good, falling moderate or poor in rain

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: Variable or West 3 or 4, increasing West or Northwest 4 or 5 later tomorrow, then

backing and increasing Southwest 5 or 6 overnight into Tuesday.

State of Sea: Moderate.

Weather: Further rain at times, gradually clearing from the west later.

Visibility: Good, falling moderate or poor in rain.
