Synopsis: Slow moving low to the northwest of Ireland.
Wind: South-southwest 6 or 7 backing south 6 or 7 occasionally gale 8 late morning, easing south-southwest 5 or 6 overnight into Monday.
State of Sea: Rough becoming moderate or rough overnight.
Weather: Isolated showers.
Visibility: Mainly good, occasionally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: Southwest 5 or 6 backing south or southeast 4 or 5 overnight into Tuesday.
State of Sea: Moderate becoming slight or moderate.
Weather: Isolated showers.
Visibility: Good, falling moderate in showers.
