



Shipping forecast for the North Irish Sea

Warnings: Strong wind in places.
Synopsis: High pressure over Scandinavia, with a ridge across much of the British Isles.
Wind: North or northeast force 4 or 5, but occasionally 6 between the Isle of Man and Cumbria especially later today and early tonight.
State of Sea: Slight occasionally moderate.
Weather: Fair, then scattered showers will spread slowly from the east this afternoon and evening.
Visibility: Good, occasionally moderate later today & tonight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: Northeast force 4 or 5 occasionally 6 at first, veering east or northeast later.
State of Sea: Slight occasionally moderate.
Weather: Isolated showers at first, then fair.
Visibility: Generally good.
