Synopsis: A slow-moving area of low pressure near Iceland will gradually fill.

Wind: South or Southwest 3 or 4, veering West or Southwest overnight, then backing South or Southwest again tomorrow morning. Becoming Variable 2 or 3 during the afternoon.

State of Sea: Slight, becoming smooth or slight.

Weather: Mainly fair, only isolated showers.

Visibility: Good, possibly moderate in any showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: Variable 2 or 3, settling South or Southeast.

State of Sea: Smooth or slight.

Weather: Mainly fair, possibly some mist and fog patches developing.

Visibility: Good, falling poor or very poor in any mist and fog patches.
