Synopsis: High to the north of the British Isles, low over Biscay
Wind: Northeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 tonight, veering east to southeast tomorrow morning then increasing 6 or 7 again later tomorrow afternoon
State of Sea: Mainly moderate, becoming moderate or rough later tomorrow
Weather: Occasional showers
Visibility: Generally good

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: East to southeast 6 or 7 decreasing 4 or 5
State of Sea: Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate
Weather: Occasional showers at first
Visibility: Good
